There are 6.375 knowledge workers in the Leiden Region.
Who are they typically?



Rents a house



Almost 6 in 10
knowledge workers are
renting a house

Comes from Poland



The top countries of
origin are Poland (17%)
and Germany (11%)

Is 30 years old



About 40% of the
knowledge workers are
25 to 35 years old

Has children?



1 in 3 knowledge workers
live with children. Of those
without, half live with their
partner and half in single
households

Works in Education



About 20% of knowledge
workers in the region are
employed in the education
sector

Earns 62K euros/year



35% of knowledge
workers have a yearly
income between 50
and 75 thousand euros

THE LABOUR MIGRANT*

There are 5.230 labour migrants in the Leiden region.
Who are they typically?



Rents a house



About 9 in 10 labour migrants are renting a house

Comes from Poland



72% of labour migrants have Polish nationality

Is 25 years old



36% of the labour migrants are 15 to 25 years old, while 35% are aged 25 to 35

Has no children



Only 1 in 5 labour migrants live with children. In fact, 28% live as a couple with no children and 35% live alone

Works in Wholesale



Wholesale and education are the most important sectors for labour migrants in the Leiden region

Earns 27K euros/year



75% of labour migrants have a yearly income between 20 and 35 thousand euros

*Labour migrants are defined by earning below the IND's highly skilled migrant salary requirements



THE INTERNATIONAL STUDENT

There are 2.320 international students in the Leiden region.
Who are they typically?



Stays more than 1 year



About 6 in 10 students stay in the Leiden region for more than 1 year

Comes from Germany



26% of students come from Germany, followed by China (11%), Greece and Italy (both 8%)

Is 20 years old



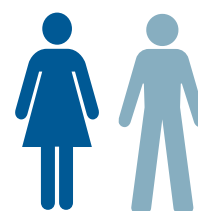
70% of students are between 15 and 25 years old

Studies at University



International students are almost exclusively enrolled in an academic university (WO)

Is a woman



65% of international students are women

THE INCOME-DEPENDENT PARTNER*

There are 1.215 income-dependent partners in the Leiden region.
Who are they typically?



Stays more than 1 year



About 6 in 10 income-dependent partners stay for more than 1 year

Comes from Poland



18% of income-dependent partner come from Poland, followed by the UK (11%) and France (10%)

Is 40 years old



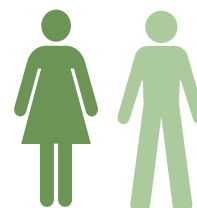
35% of the income-dependent partners is between 35 and 45 years old

Has children



55% live with their partner and child(ren)

Is a woman



62% of income-dependent partners are women

*Income-dependent partners are defined as non-Dutch persons who are not economically active and have an international partner who is economically active
