

# Tips for travelling to and in Maastricht

## Do a smart travel check before you leave

Plan your trip to Maastricht in advance and have a look at the parking options. Visit [www.maastrichtbereikbaar.nl](http://www.maastrichtbereikbaar.nl) to see the Smart map which lists road closures, diversions, traffic, and parking options. Good to know: the rules for safely navigating the city.

	It is cheaper to park on the outskirts than in the city centre.
	Opening hours: 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Walking time to the city centre: 10 minutes.
	<b>P+R Maastricht Noord:</b> free parking and bus 3, 10 or 30 to the city centre for €2.40 per person (day-return ticket).
	<b>Shared bikes:</b> use a shared bicycle to travel between the train stations and a number of locations in the centre. Please visit our website to see all the locations.

Free parking and a bus to the city centre for €2.40 p.p. **A**

€1.50 = 54 minutes / €12 per day **B**
