The Sea

After an overdose of colours and fragrances from the flowers, you can see, smell and feel the healthy sea, and experience the peace and wide-open space. The first coastal light in Noordwijk dates back to 1444; it wasn't until the 19th century that the first wooden light-house was built. The current distinctive white lighthouse on Koningin Wilhelmina Boulevard dates from 1923. It has six floors, 108 steps and a light height of over 33 metres, and is built from brick and reinforced concrete.

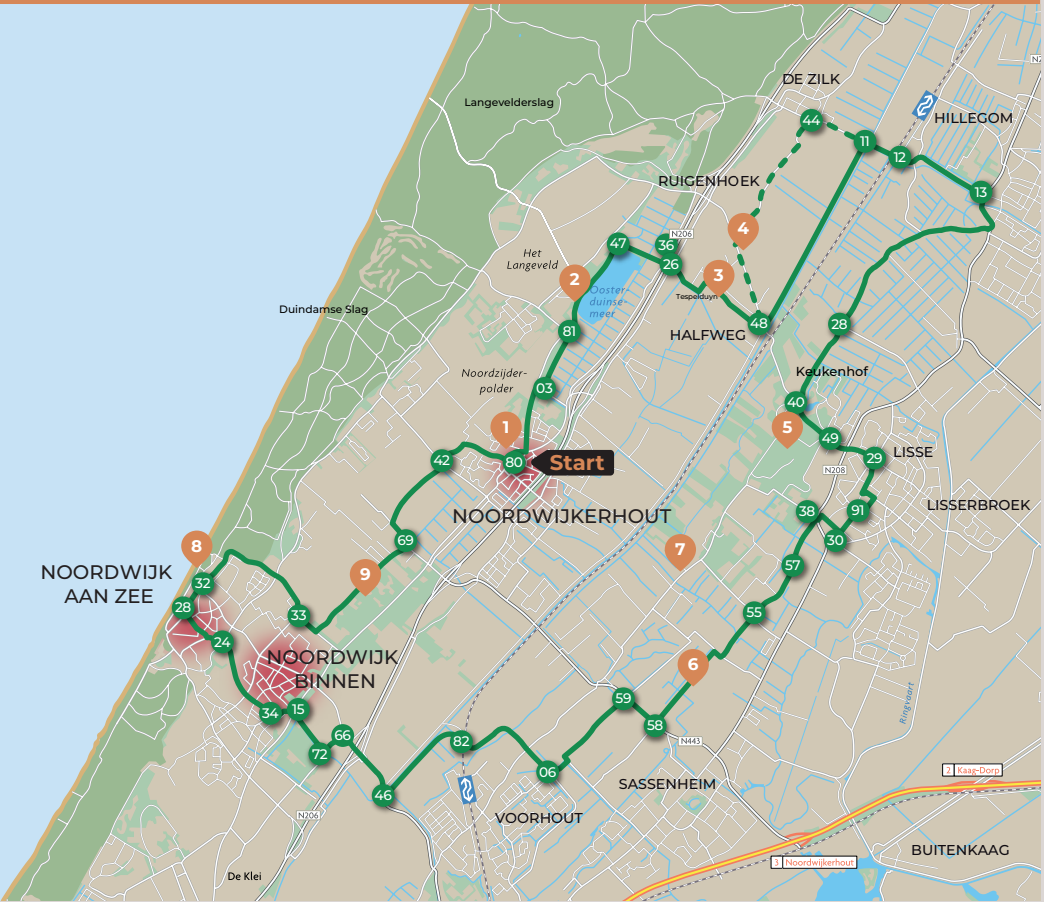

Enjoy the flowers



Cycle along the most beautiful blooming bulb fields of the Dutch Flower Region.
Enjoy an explosion of colours and fragrances.

A beautiful spring bike ride past blooming fields full of daffodils, hyacinths and tulips, as well as the beach and the villages. You won't know where to look first.

For the Enjoy the Flowers cycling route, follow the numbered junctions (KP) of the cycling junction network. You follow the route by riding from one number to the next. The junctions and connections are clearly signposted with green and white signs.

Start and finishpoint

Enjoy the colourful flower fields, but please respect the 'Flower Line'. The bulb fields are privately owned and walking on them damages both flowers and bulbs. That's why we ask you to stay behind the Flower Line and take your photos from the edge or an official Photo Spot #enjoyourflowers.

Noordwijkerhout

Village life in Noordwijkerhout revolves around the Witte Kerk (White Church), whose origins date back to around 1300. In spring and summer, the square turns into one big terrace, always lively and welcoming.

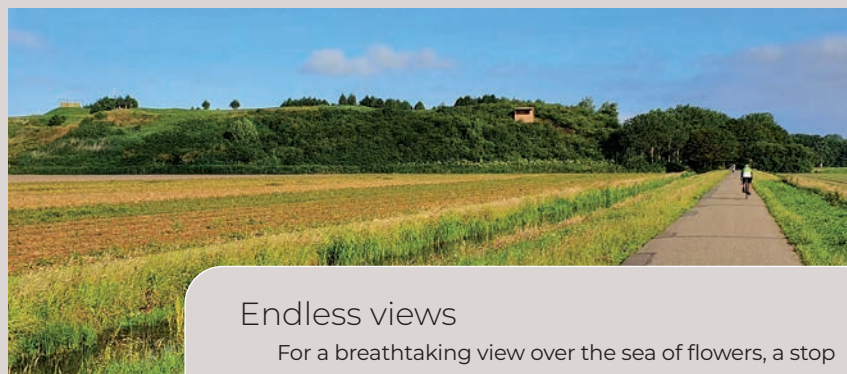

Endless views

For a breathtaking view over the sea of flowers, a stop at the Tespelduyn viewpoint - right in the heart of Hollandse Duinen National Park - is a must. On a clear day, from 14 metres up you can even see as far as The Hague and Amsterdam. This area has a rich history, with a landscape shaped by former sand excavations and bulb cultivation.

TIP: Tespelduyn is also a wonderful spot for lunch or dinner, or a round of golf.

Tulip Experience Amsterdam

A place where you are allowed to step into the fields for your best photo: Tulip Experience Amsterdam. Visit the show garden with around 4 million tulips and as many as 700 varieties, explore the bulb and tulip museum, and create your own bouquet. A truly unique experience.

Keukenof Castle

The route passes the world-famous spring park Keukenhof. Also take a look at the estate of Keukenhof Castle, free to visit, beautifully located and a green oasis of peace and quiet.

TIP: In summer and late summer, the castle garden is filled with around 150 varieties of dahlias in many colours and shapes.
